



Tipsy Taggin' is an instructor led graffiti painting class and is a refreshing alternative to the conventional sip and paint class.





- Wine and other spirits are encouraged, but not required.
- The Tipsy Taggin' class uses non- toxic water based aerosol spray paint.
- Mask and gloves and all other COVID-19 social distance measures will be followed.

The duration of the class is approximately two hours. We have broken the process of making graffiti into simple steps that can be easily followed. Experience in art making not necessary.






Class Overview:

- -spray paint safety, protective gear training ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING (10 minutes)
- -Familiarity with spray paint colors, finishes, caps (nozzles) (5 minutes)
- -slide show of images for inspiration (5 minutes)
- *based on availability of projector
- -Test spray students will use various nozzles to get the feel of using aerosol spray paint to make art (10 minutes)
- Students will work on their masterpiece with guidance from the instructor (remainder of the class)



Tipsy Taggin is \$50.00 per person. The cost includes 2 hours of instruction and all related materials.

The fee does NOT include beverages, food or parking.



Each class must have a minimum of 5 students and a maximum of 10.
